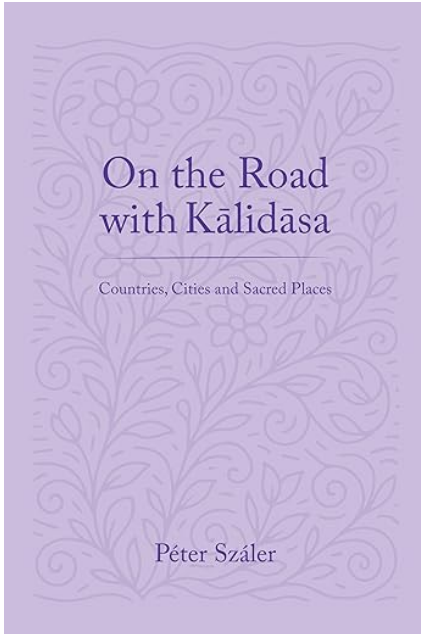


## On the Road with Kalidasa: Countries, Cities and Sacred Places



### About the Book

This book uses the perspectives of humanistic geography and classical philology to explore the representation of space in Kālidāsa's works. It identifies three spatial levels – macro, mezzo and micro – reflecting the focaliser's movement within the narratives. Readers of this book are invited to embark on an imaginary journey to Kālidāsa's world, where places from his time and his imagination are revealed simultaneously.
