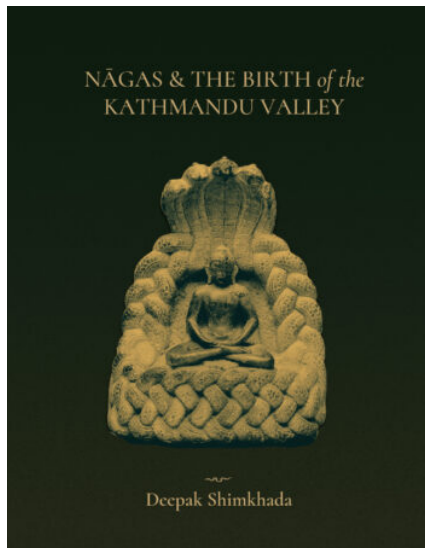


Nagas and the Birth of the Kathmandu Valley
