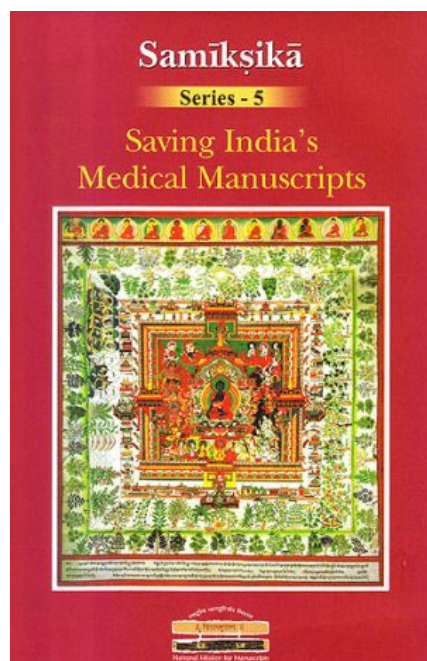


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Saving India's Medical Manuscripts (Samiksika Series-5)



About the Book

The National Mission for Manuscripts was established in February 2003 by the Ministry of Culture. Its purpose is to locate, document, preserve and disseminate the knowledge content of Indian manuscripts.
