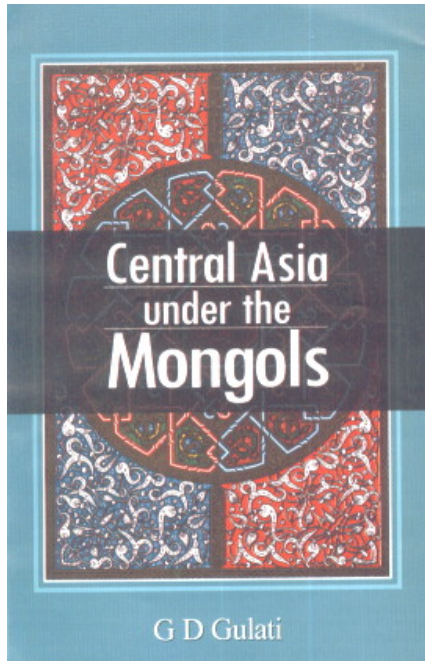


Central Asia Under the Mongols
