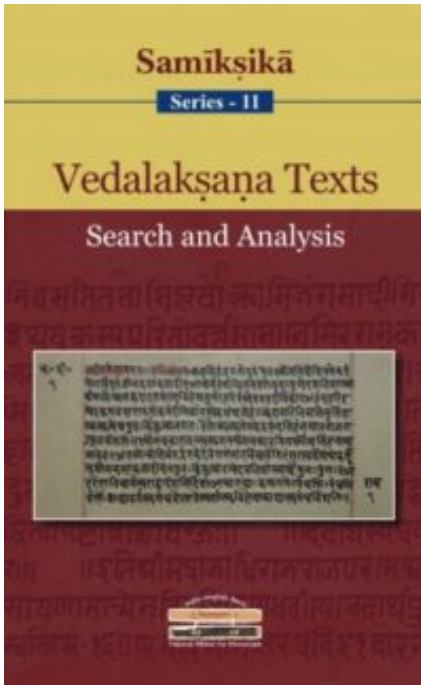


Vedalaksana Texts: Search and Analysis (Samiksika Series – 11)
