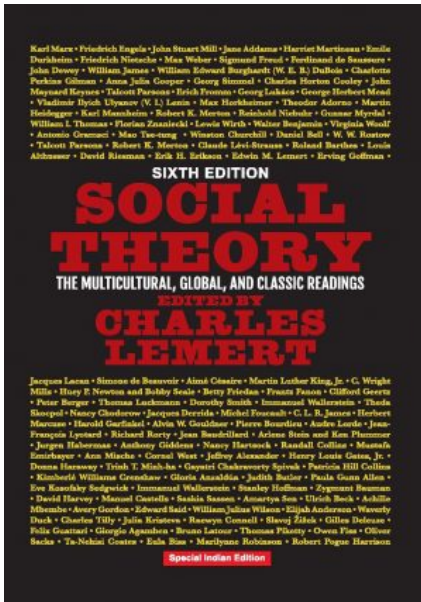


Social Theory: The Multicultural, Global, and Classic Readings, 6th Edition
